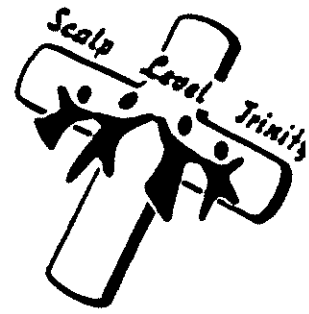

And what the Lord has been doing since the day that team met back in the Secretary's office when the Holy Spirit spoke.

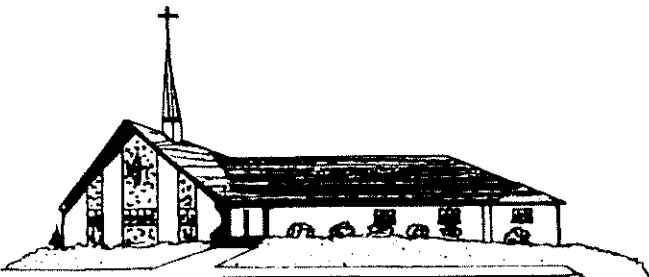
Praise God!!

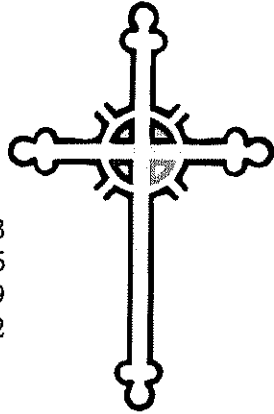
